Also called "Operation Hummingbird" or the "Rohm-Putsch," the Night of the Long Knives was an event during which Hitler's SS troops committed a series of political murders. By the end of the event, Adolf Hitler appeared to have complete control over Germany but, like most dictators, he constantly feared that he might be ousted by others who were more powerful than he. The four million brown-shirted Nazi storm troopers, the SA (Sturmabteilung), included many members who actually believed in the Nazi ideology.
